# of the Intercountry Committee Egypt on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2016 in Assuan

Both sections of the Intercountry Committee Egypt convened on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2016 in Assuan at the occasion of the District Conference D 2451.

Mrs Soheir Wahib, Chair of the Egyptian Section of the Intercountry Committee Egypt, welcomes the participants and stresses the merits of the Intercountry Committee's activities during the Rotarian year 2015/16. She begins with the closing of the agreement concerning the constant cooperation between the two sections dated 12<sup>th</sup> May 2014 (vide the Annual Report 2013/14) and continues with the description of the ensuing contacts and all social projects that emanated therefrom. In particular, she finds words of praise for the joint projects to connect

houses to the various local Drinking Water Systems. This is furthered and supported by the plans of District 2451 outlined in 2013 to finance appr. 2000 connections per year.

DG Zierl thanked her for the invitation and comments on the great engagement and dedication shown by a number of clubs in Munich for the realization of several social service projects in Egypt. In this context, projects for the improvement of the drinking water supply are points of particular importance. The project "Water for a Healthy Life", which was initiated at the occasion of his visit to Egypt and which is jointly carried by the RC El Maadi and the RC München Land, requires 360.000 US\$ and will lead to a connection of roughly 1.700 houses in Central Egypt. The Federal Republic of Germany provides for the greater share of the funding required.

The various discussions following Gov. Zierl's speech all resulted in the confirmation of the intent of both sections to intensify the cooperation and to deepen the connections between clubs in Germany and Egypt.

The chairman of the German Section, Frank Müller-Römer, informs the assembly of the presentation of his section in the internet, and of the fact that an English version thereof is available.
