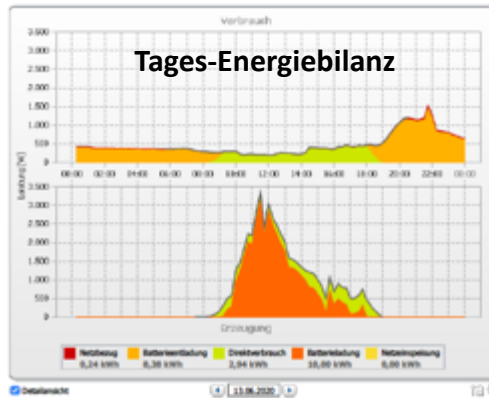
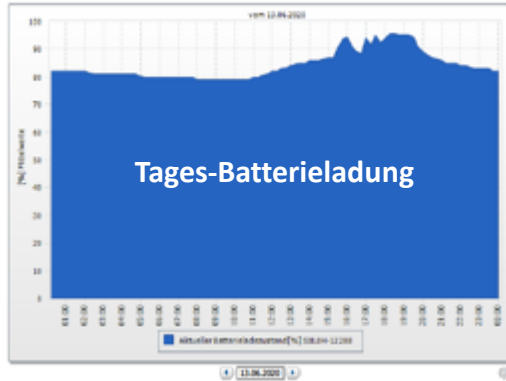

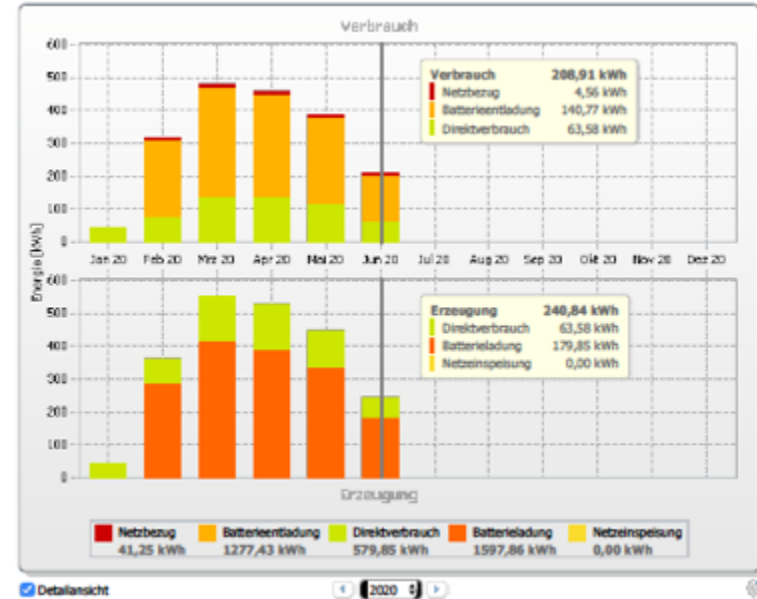


Dezentrales Kraftwerk auf Basis eines Solarfeldes und Li-Batteriespeicher: 75 kWh

INTRODUCTION

Honorable Prof. Dr Wolfgang Schade, first we are happy to have you and your members here in our village mazinga your warmly welcome.

Second we are glad you made it through a long journey from Germany up to here despite travelling through the water but you made it here we are so honored with your visit here and we humbly appreciate.

SHORT HISTORY OF MAZINGA VILLAGE.

The Village mazinga was registered to be a village in the year 1976, this village consists of four islands, also it has total of 1600 people and people started to live in this village since 18 century. People in this village depend much on fishing for 60 percent as the means of their daily earning while 35 percent are farmers and 5 percent are small business owners.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

The village has only one primary school also it has one Dispensary which provides service to the mazinga ward which has more than 8200 people who comes from 11 islands.

CHALLENGES

Patient transport (boat)

The Dispensary has to wards for the patients to sleep in and this is a major problem especially to women who are waiting to give birth.

The Village Council has already bought blocks 7500 and started to collect sand and stones so as to start to build the ward for women and children which it estimate to cost up to Tsh 50,000,000 (fifty million). The problem is the money to buy factory equipments such as cement, deer, iron

sheets etc. Also the Dispensary has no microscope that makes the service provided to be of guessing especial to those patients with stomach pain.

Today we are witnessing the clean water project which is being build which will help to get clean water in our village, before this was the big problem in our village and we say thank you and God Bless you.

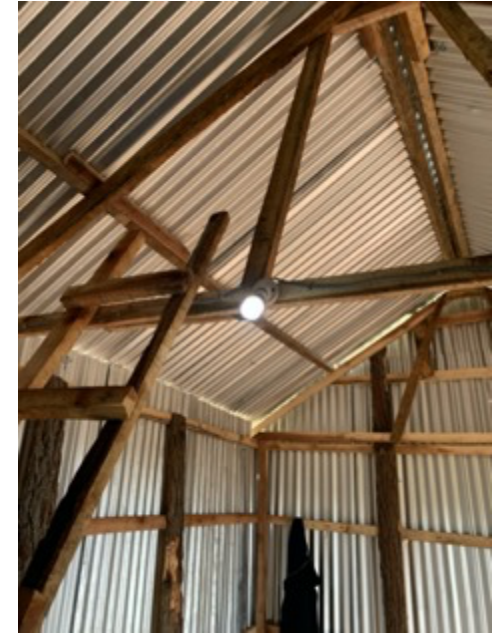
WHAT WE ARE ASKING
